RATIONALE

HOMELESSNESS IS A COLLECTIVE RESPONSIBILITY.

The Resource Folder for the Homeless has been produced by the Manly Community Centre to offer a range of information to local service providers building service systems effective in assisting homeless and transient people.

OUR OBJECTIVE

It is the Centre's objective to provide a resource card for the homeless and the itinerant and a resource kit with a summary of key contact services for agencies on the Northern Beaches.

OUR VISION

We envisage that the Card and Kit will help the Homeless to:

- Overcome the stress of dealing with multiple service providers as no one-stop shop exists for them
- Feel empowered to seek help for themselves
- Improve access to referral agencies based on their needs.



MEANINGS OF HOMELESSNESS

DEFINITIONS

The most commonly accepted definition of homelessness is Mackenzie and Chamberlain's definition which includes three categories in recognition of the diversity of homelessness.

The definition is based on the premise that concepts of homelessness and housing are culturally bound and that in order to define homelessness it is necessary to identify shared community standards about minimum housing.

PRIMARY HOMELESSNESS

Experienced by people without conventional accommodation (e.g. sleeping rough or in improvised dwellings).

SECONDARY HOMELESSNESS

Experienced by people who frequently move from one temporary shelter to another (e.g. emergency accommodation, youth refuges, "couchsurfing").

TERTIARY HOMELESSNESS

Experienced by people staying in accommodation that falls below minimum community standards (e.g. boarding housing and caravan parks). This definition was adopted by the Commonwealth Advisory Committee on Homelessness in 2001 and is widely used in our sector.
